

# Fourth Grade Summer Reading Assignment and Project:

This assignment is due on the first day back to school in  
September, 2017.

Late projects will have 10pts.deducted each day. Projects not  
handed in will result in a zero for Language Arts.

Read any book from the “Who Was ....” series by  
Scholastic. You may choose any famous historical *person* that  
interests you. These books are illustrated biographical  
chapter books that can be found at Scholastic, Barnes N  
Noble or any other book store. The prices range from \$3.00  
to \$5.00.

1. First read the entire book about your historical person  
and take notes along the way of important dates with events.

2. Create an interesting biography poster and include the  
following on a 3-fold poster board:

the name of your famous person

a “sketched” portrait of your famous person in pencil done  
by you

a timeline of your person's life (include at least 8 dates and events)

a full paragraph (5 to 8 sentences) that explains why your person is famous

6 to 8 adjectives that describe your person

a life lesson - something you learned from this person

a quote from this person - something this person said that was important

any other interesting facts about your person that are not in your timeline, but are in the book

pictures of your famous person from the internet

decorate and design your poster board in a way that reflects your historical figure

Presentation - present your book and poster board at school to your classmates
